The goal of APC grants is to enhance and enrich the educational experience of AHS students in new and innovative ways.

Submissions

- Must be submitted during the formal submission period for both fall (late August mid-late September) and spring (late January - mid-late February) grants. No late applications will be considered.
- Individual requests may not exceed \$5,000.
- Submissions may be made by any person affiliated with Acalanes
- High School including administrators, teachers, staff, parents and students.

Guidelines

- Grants will ultimately be approved by the Acalanes principal so they are consistent with the goals of the school.
- Submissions should reach as many students as possible.
- Grant requests should not compete with funding goals of community partner Lafayette Partners in Education (LPIE).
- Proposals should not be for recurring activities.
- Submissions from student clubs run by ASB will not be considered as there is a separate grant program run by ASB Leadership.

Funding of Selected Grants

- Fall grants should be utilized/funded by March 15 of the spring semester and spring grants should be utilized/funded by September 15 of the following semester.
- Reimbursements should be forwarded to the APC Treasurer or APC Grants Coordinator.
