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



Surviving the Application Process

- Take a deep breath
- Get Organized
- Put important dates on the calendar
- Keep track of logins and passwords
- Check email regularly
- Be realistic with your list



Student's Role - Own the process

- Create and complete applications
- Research options
- Create and complete applications
- Use the resources at school--academy, lunch etc.
- Take care of business at school-- order transcripts,
 ask for letters of rec, provide student statement

Parent/Guardian Role

- Support your student
- Share your experience
- Research together all college options using tools available:
 - Naviance Super Match
 - Naviance College Match
 - Niche
 - Big Future
 - College Hunch (app)
 - College Confidential
 - College Data
- Complete Parent Statement in Naviance
- Help manage deadlines, set aside time for college discussion that is stress free.

Community Colleges

- Open Enrollment beginning Feb. Apply early.
- No SAT/ACT required
- Orientation in Spring
- Priority transfer to UC's and CSU's
- Honors Transfer Program
- Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG 6 Schools)
- Residential Housing available (11 California schools have this option)



College List - Where to Begin

- Naviance Scattergrams
- Campus Tours and Information Sessions
- Admission Rep Visits to Acalanes



Building a Good List

- Academic Fit AND Financial Fit
- Apply to 6 9 schools
 - 2 3 Likely
 - 3 4 Possible
 - 1 2 Stretch
- Any school you apply to is a school you WANT to attend.
- Love your list.

Types of Applications

UC Application

- Self reported grades (no transcripts)
- Official test scores
- Activities and Awards list
- Personal Insight Questions (respond to 4 out of 8 questions - 350 word max)

CSU Application

- Self reported grades (no transcripts)
- Official test scores

****NO letters of recommendation required

Common Application

- 800 Schools
- Official test scores
- Activities & Awards
- Essay (Choose 1 of 7 options- 650 words)
- Counselor Recommendation
- Teacher Letter(s) of recommendation

Coalition Application

- 120 schools
- University of Washington and others

Types of Application Review

Index Review

- GPA & courses
- Test scores
- Optional essay or short response











Holistic Review

- Academics
 - Grades, coursework, rigor
 - Standardized tests SAT or ACT
- Achievement outside the classroom (extracurricular activities, employment, volunteer work, etc.)
 - Commitment and Leadership
- Context of High School achievements
- Personal Qualities essays and letters of recommendation
- Match/Fit and demonstrated interest





UC Application

- Application is Open Now!
- Filing period: November 1st-November 30th
- Requires 4 personal Insight Questions (Choose from 8)
- SAT Reasoning or ACT with writing (send to 1 campus)
- No letters of recommendation (unless requested)
- No transcripts (unless requested)





CSU Application

- Applications online
- Filing period: Oct. 1st-Nov.30th
- SAT Reasoning or ACT w/o writing (use 3594 to send to all)
- Writing score not used in eligibility determination
- NO: Essay, Subject Tests, Letters of Rec., Transcripts (unless requested)
- No extracurricular activities (except SLO)





Common Application

- Over 800 schools participate
- Complete ONE application for many schools
- Most likely will need letter(s) of recommendation
- Supplemental materials for specific schools
- Sync Naviance with Common App by signing FERPA on Naviance





Private and Out-of-State Colleges


- Apply NOW through college's website, Common App, or Coalition
- May require Supplemental Essays
- Interviews optional but important
- Resume of Extracurricular Activities
- Letters of Recommendation
 - Counselor
 - Teacher
 - Secondary School Report (counselor)
- Mid-year report
- Transcript



Application Timeline

Late Summer/Early Fall:	Rolling admission begins
August 1	UC and Common Applications open
October 1	CSU Application opens, FAFSA submission begins
Mid-Oct Mid-Nov.	Early Action/Early Decision deadlines
Nov. 1 - Nov. 30:	UC/CSU Application filing period
Dec. 1 - Feb. 1:	Regular decision deadlines
December - January	Early Action/Early Decision notifications
March	Community College applications
April	Placement testing (community college)
March - April	Regular decision notifications

- Is your name spelled correctly and does it match your college application?
- State ID
- Mistakes?



- Write out the full name of college
- Change quantity
- UC's and CSU's self report



Standardized Tests

- October Early Decision and Early Action
- November SLO & San Diego State (SAT Reasoning)
- December LAST MONTH TO TEST!
 - SAT Subject Test
 - UC & CSU will accept December test



Submitting Applications

- Print/take a screenshot and keep a copy of EVERYTHING
- Keep separate files for each school
- Don't wait until the last minute Systems do crash and they won't allow late submissions.



NCAA

- Register student with eligibility center if you haven't already!
- Send transcript and official test scores to NCAA
- Core Course requirements
- Follow recruiting rules

- Update College List
- Match Naviance account with the CommonApp

- Use "Net Price Calculator" on school financial aid sites to understand Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
- Each school has a different financial aid deadline.
